Each nominee must 1) be 18 years old and a resident of the district which he/she represents, 2) complete and submit an application, and 3) submit ten (10) signatures from residents who are 18 years old or older and live within their district.

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This special vacancy notice is provided in accordance with the Maddy Act, Government Code, sections 54970-54974, which requires posting of special vacancy notices for vacancies on boards and commissions that are not listed on the City’s list of anticipated vacancies for 2021.
