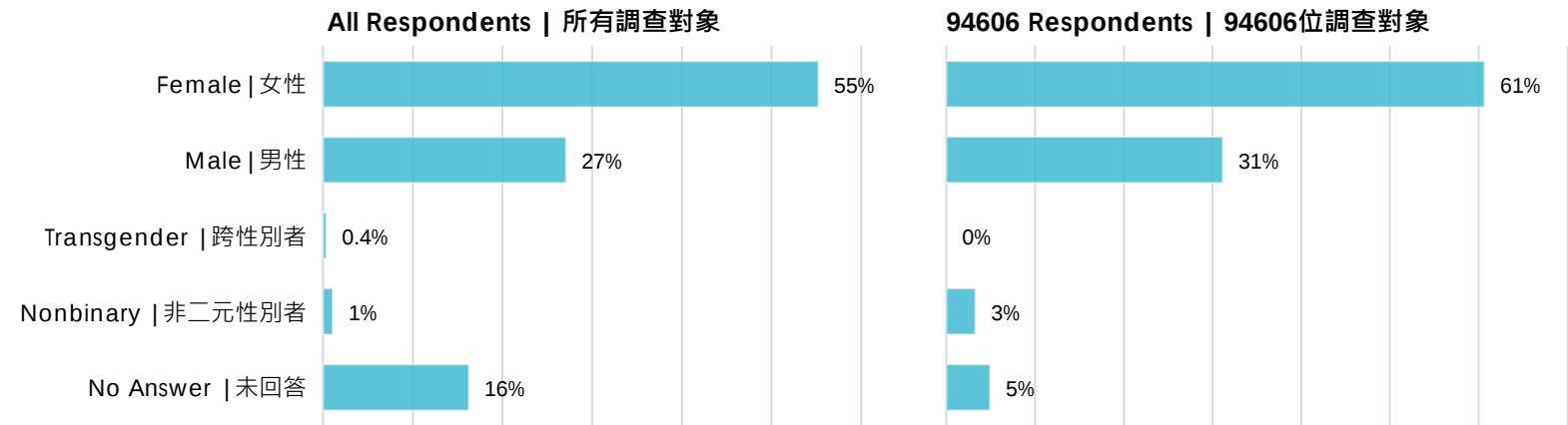

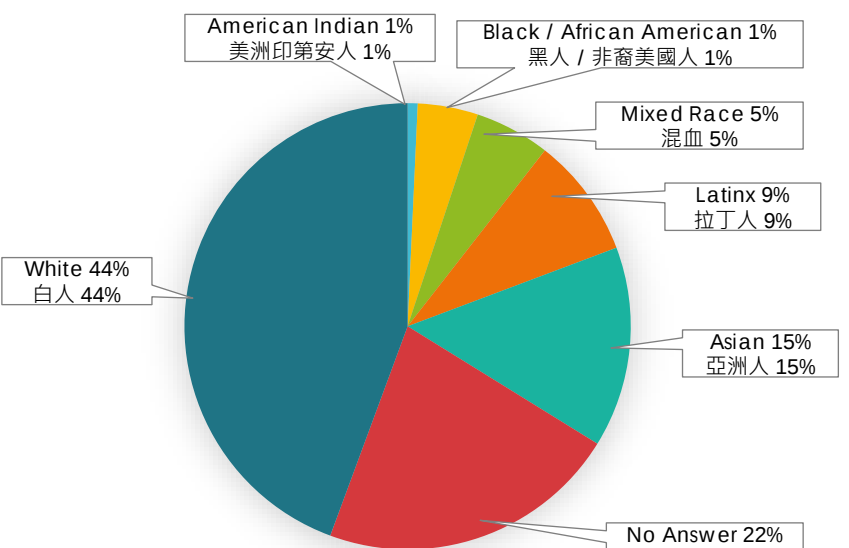
Survey Results: Demographics | 問卷調查結果：人口統計數據



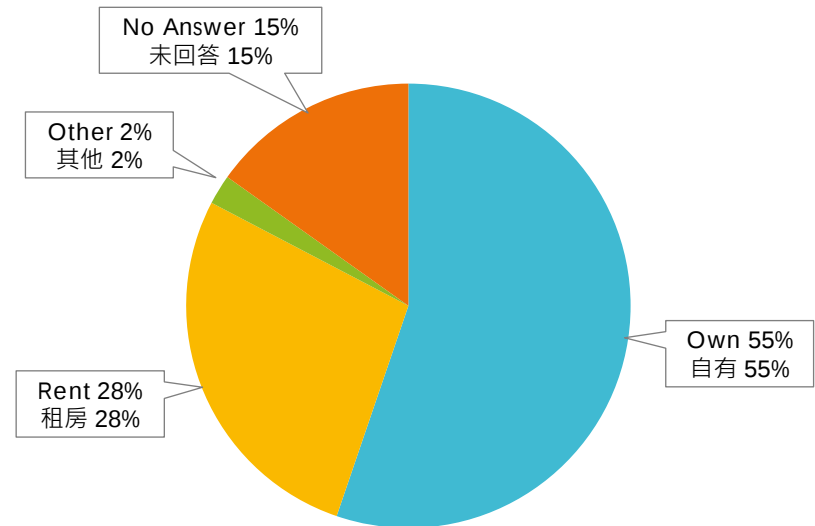
Racial Makeup of 94606 Respondents

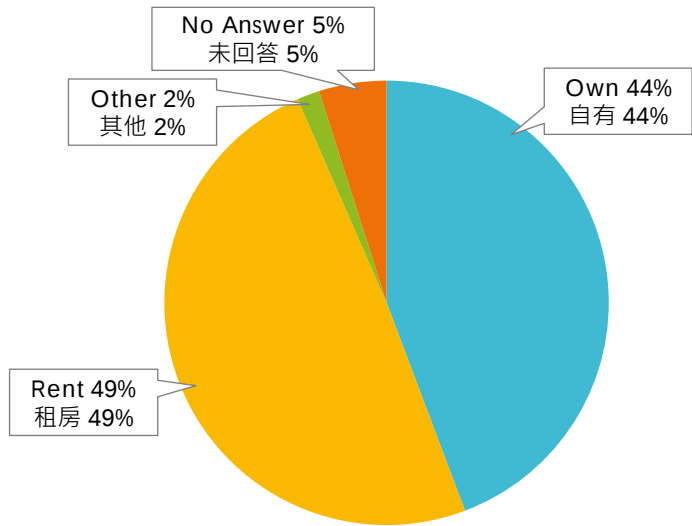
Gender of Respondents

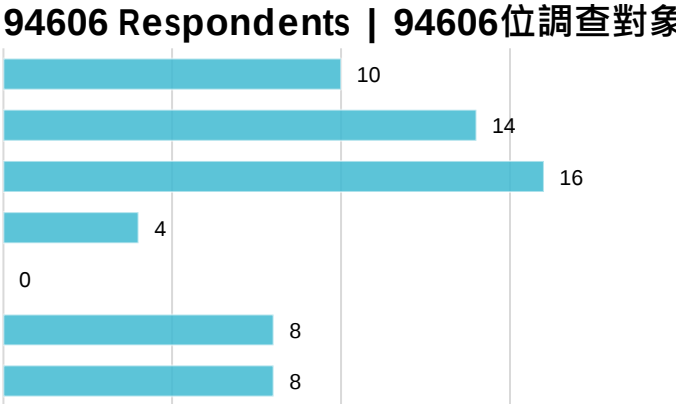
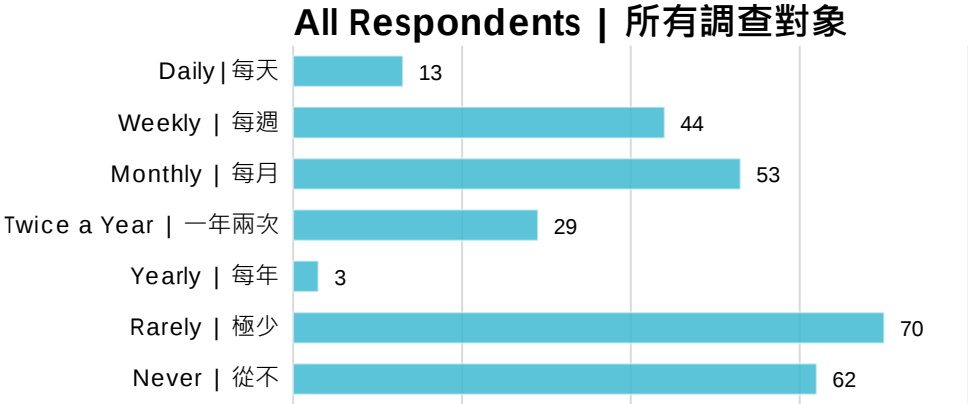
Home Ownership Status of Respondents

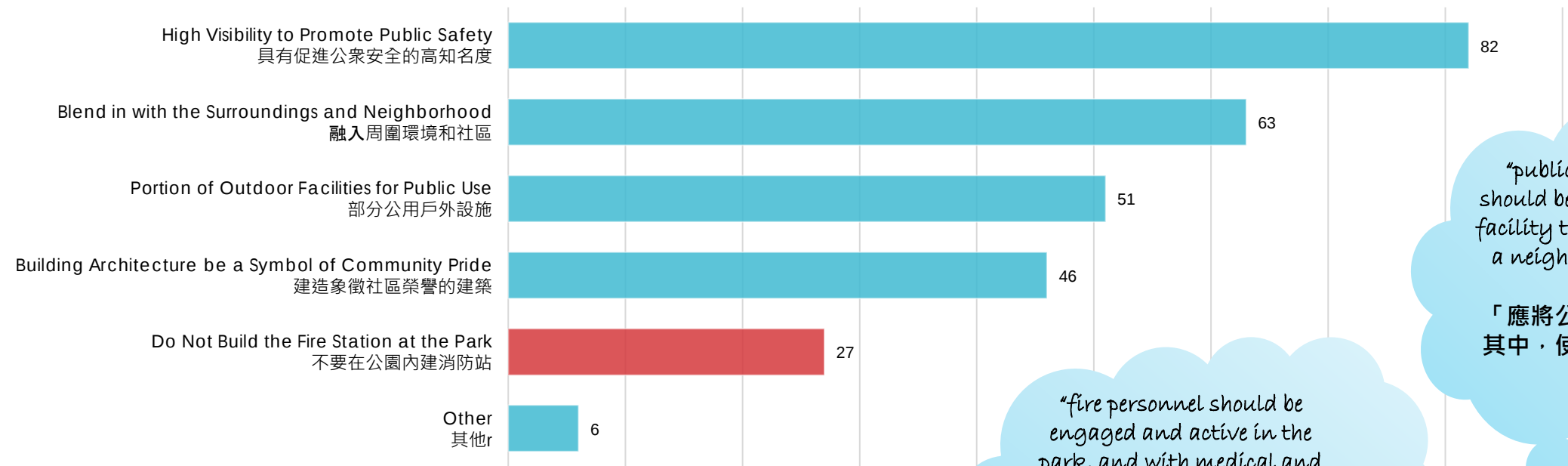

Fire Station Site Study | 消防站場地研究

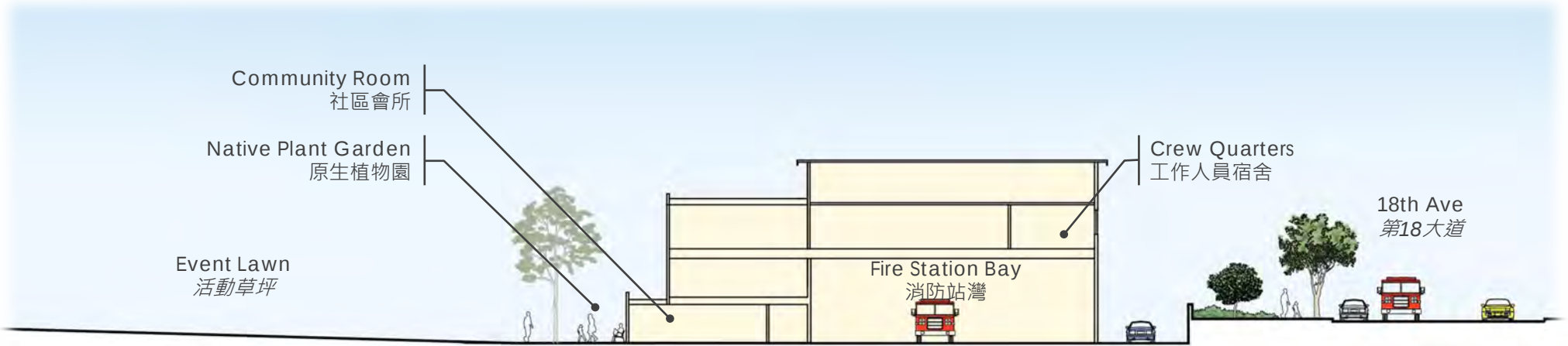
- The City's Real Estate staff have researched potential properties within the service area of Fire Station 4 and have found most them unsuitable or owners unresponsive.
- A modern drive-through fire station requires a lot size approximately **140-ft wide and 240-ft deep** in order to safely accommodate the required turning radius of the fire trucks.
- While not optimal, in order to reduce the footprint, the Oakland Fire Department is opting for a "back-in" station at San Antonio Park, thereby reducing the site requirement to **135-ft wide and 180-ft deep**.
- 本市房地產職員對4號消防站服務區內的潛在房產進行了調查，發現大多數房產都不合適或者業主未作出答覆。
- 現代化直通式消防站大約需要**140英尺寬、240英尺深**的土地面積，以為消防車提供安全轉彎所需的空間。
- 雖然並非最佳位置，但為了減少佔地面積，屋市消防局選擇在San Antonio公園的一個“倒車”站，從而將場地要求降低至**135英尺寬、180英尺深**。
