Qualifications

Councilmember - Citizen of the United States, resident and registered voter of the City and designated District for *at least thirty days* at the time nomination papers are issued.

City Auditor – Citizen of the United States, resident and registered voter of the City for *at least thirty days* at the time nomination papers are issued. Certified by the California State Board of Accountancy as a Certified Public Accountant or by the Institute of Internal Auditors as a Certified Internal Auditor.

Mayor - Citizen of the United States, registered voter and resident of the City for *at least thirty days* at time nomination papers are issued.

School Board Director - Citizen of the United States, resident and registered voter of the City and designated District for *at least thirty days* at the time nomination papers are issued.

Candidate's Filing Fee

The “non-refundable” filing fee for the City of Oakland is \$1,000*. The full amount can be paid when the papers are issued or \$50 can be paid when the papers are issued and the balance can be paid when the papers are filed. Checks should be payable to the City of Oakland.

Nomination Period

Opens 8:30 AM – Monday, July 18, 2022
Closes 5:00 PM – Friday, August 12, 2022

If the incumbent does not file, then the nomination period is extended for five (5) days to Wednesday, August 17, 2022.

Nomination Papers are issued AND filed only in the Office of the City Clerk located at City Hall, 1 Frank Ogawa Plaza, 2nd Floor, Oakland, CA. Please call the Office of the City Clerk, if you have any questions.

To ensure proper processing, please plan to file your nomination papers with the Office of the City Clerk at the earliest possible time. Plan to spend at least 20 minutes in our office to accurately complete the filing process. Please type or legibly print all information on your forms as this will help avoid delays and prevent errors.
