Please ensure that the following recommendations are incorporated into the charter:

I believe that every Commissioner should have common knowledge of general points of reference of the city's geography.

- Commissioner must survey and gain general knowledge of the districts.
- Commissioner or a subcommittee of Commissioners should go out and survey by observation any material points of contention in the mapping process.

I believe that these measures are critical to bring about more meaningful conversation and consideration in the mapping process.

Also, during the mapping process there should be a limit on the number of maps that a Commissioner may work on during the mapping process. (I.e. - if a Commissioner is developing and submitting a map independently then the Commissioner should not be allowed to also contribute to the design and submission of additional maps during the drawing process.
