

F5 created through live mapping starting from prior work recorded as F4:

- F4 created by importing adjustments from Districtr Plan 100796 drafted by commr Goode:
- G7: Coliseum is in G7 with adjacent neighborhoods
- G7: Oak Knoll, King Estate Park and the Seneca reservoir are moved to F6
- F6: Maxwell Park is back in F6 (it was in E5 in Map F3)
- F6: the southern border extends to the waterfront
- E5: Latina population is 50% and CVAP is 30.4%
- E5: Bridges Academy is in E5
- E5: the western border moves to 19th Ave & Foothill then over to 23rd Ave above Foothill Blvd
- E5: 23rd Ave below foothill blvd is in one district and not used as the district border

Further Edits made using lines from Districtr Plan 100924 drafted by Chair Gangas:

- C3/B2: Lake Merritt put back in 2 districts while also keeping other COI together
- C3: Black artists COI such as Molanga Center made whole in C3
- C3: Keep Westlake School, Mosswood Park, BAMBD in C3
- B2: Trestle Glenn unified in B2

Work Continued during live mapping to make the following changes:

- Unify Coliseum Neighborhood, by moving F6/G7 boundary to Hegenberger, per Marshall/Achtenberg
- Unify Rancho San Antonio and avoid breaking the 23rd ave business area, by moving the B2/E5 boundary to 25th ave, south of Foothill
- Place Bartlett into E5 for population
- Capture 2 census blocks in the vicinity of Trestle Glen into B2 with Trestle Glen
- Extend A1 boundary in Adams Points for population
- Move areas north of Grove Shafter Fwy (24) and East of Warren Fwy (13) into D4 for population.
- After discussion, move Coliseum and contained blocks into F6.
