

PROVIDE TO TENANTS PRIOR TO COMMENCING REPAYMENT NEGOTIATIONS

## NOTICE TO TENANTS REGARDING REPAYMENT NEGOTIATIONS

(Eviction Moratorium Ordinance Regulations, Section 7.B)

You cannot be evicted for unpaid rent that became due during the Coronavirus (Covid-19) Local Emergency if your failure to pay was due to a substantial reduction in household income or substantial increase in expenses resulting from the pandemic.

Property owners and tenants are encouraged to enter into repayment agreements for unpaid rent that became due during the Local Emergency. A property owner may not charge or collect late fees or interest on such unpaid rent. Repayment agreements may not be conditioned on changes to the lease terms or removal of housing services but may waive portions of what the tenant owes.

## PLEASE TAKE NOTICE:

- You have the right to refuse to enter into a repayment agreement or engage in repayment negotiations;
- It is unlawful for a property owner to retaliate against you for refusing to enter into a repayment agreement or engage in negotiations;
- You are not required to apply for or otherwise specially qualify for a repayment plan;
- You have the right to choose to consult with an attorney before entering into a repayment agreement or engaging in repayment negotiations;
- You have the right to rescind the repayment agreement for up to thirty (30) days after it is fully executed by all parties;
- Neutral, third party mediation services are available at no cost through the Rent Adjustment Program;
