



- 3. Bid document preparation for replanting and repair of irrigation system to begin in February.


























Permits and Funding

Watershed Lands Acquisition


Worked with consultant to map priority acquisitions via a GIS model using

- Ecological factors: creeks, regional conservation planning, rare plant and animal occurrence and habitat
- **Equity factors**: areas targeted for increased investment by the City to achieve racial and other equity goals

Next Steps

- •Overlay parcels on the model
- •Remove already protected lands
- Evaluate prioritized parcels for price, willing landowner, other site specific, and overall strategic factors
- •Share plans with potential funders
- •Reach out to property owners regarding acquisitions

Watershed Lands Acquisition

- Potential partnership with East Bay Regional Park District on Claremont Canyon expansion
- Potential Derby Creek parcel donation from County Tax Assessor to City after November 2023
- Longer term
 - Coordinating with EBRPD on landfill closure @ Dunsmuir Chabot parcels purchased with DD funds
 - Potential conservation easement of Temescal Creek headwaters undeveloped parcels
 - Feelers out to various property owner on donation and/or sale of property and conservation easements
 - Internal coordination with City departments on conservation planning
