



 - City Contract Services has and continues to be short-staffed




Lake Merritt Channel Improvements at 10th Street




Lake Merritt Channel at 10th Street

1. Existing conditions plant surveys complete
2. Wetland delineation confirmed
3. Meetings scheduled for December 7 with environmental regulatory agencies to initiate closing out environmental regulatory permits
4. Trash and homeless encampments persist
5. Fence to remain to protect wetland habitat until encampments are resolved




Tide Gate Operations Guidance for the 7th Street Flood Control Facility








Estuary Park

- Draft California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Environmental Impact Report (EIR) Addendum in process
- Phase 1 construction ~Fall 2025



Union Point Park to 23rd Avenue Trail aka Miller Milling to Cemex E. 7th St to 23rd/29th Aves



- Proposal for cost estimating easement acquisitions of the three private properties due before end of November.




Waterfront Trail at Fruitvale (Fruitvale Bridge Gap Closure)




Waterfront Trail at Fruitvale (Fruitvale Bridge Gap Closure)

Waterfront Trail Connections at Park and High Street Bridges




Waterfront Trail Connections at Park and High Street Bridges

Waterfront Trail Connection at Park Street Bridge – Conceptual Plan




Waterfront Trail Connection at Park Street Bridge – Conceptual Elevation View



PROJECT AREAS IN COURTLAND CREEK PARK



- Restore ~950 feet of open creek
 - improve habitat and water quality
 - reduce trash and illegal dumping
 - repair steep and eroding creek banks
- Provide accessible seating, gathering places, and a creek overlook

Design

- 95% designs have been reviewed and comments are being incorporated
- 100% designs expected by 12/1/2022

Funding

Requested additional funding from California Department of Water Resources to cover additional project costs

Permits - external

- Requested a minor change to Alameda County Flood Control bifurcation structure
- All external permits in-place

Permits – City of Oakland

- Creek Protection, tree removal, and grading permits to be issued

Request for Proposals (RFPs)

- Contract negotiation in process for tree removal to be completed in January 2023
- Creek restoration RFP to be issued in January for work to commence in June/July 2023

Watershed Lands Acquisition

- Potential partnership with East Bay Regional Park District on Claremont Canyon expansion
- Potential Derby Creek parcel donation from County Tax Assessor to City after November 2023
- Longer term
 - Coordinating with EBRPD on landfill closure @ Dunsmuir Chabot parcels purchased with DD funds
 - Waiting on response from Segorea Te Land Trust regarding a potential conservation easement of Temescal Creek headwaters undeveloped parcels
 - Feelers out to various property owner on donation and/or sale of property and conservation easements
 - Internal coordination with City departments on conservation planning
