Subscribe to sufficient trash service

When residents and business owners don't have sufficient service at their homes or businesses for weekly curbside trash pickup, the overflow can end up on Oakland streets. **Contact Waste Management of Alameda County to subscribe or adjust your service at (510) 613-8710 or csnorthbay@wm.com.**

You can also visit Recyclewhere.org to look up options for whatever you want to throw away or recycle.

Use your bulky pickup service

Every Oakland resident, including apartment dwellers, is entitled to an annual curbside Bulky Pickup for items that don't fit in their trash carts. IT'S YOUR RIGHT! Tenants, please have your property owner schedule an appointment or inquire about the waiver that will allow you to schedule appointments yourself.

Avoid the line at the dump, and schedule a free pickup from the comfort of your home!

Attend a Bulky Block Party

Residents can also dispose of their bulky items at no charge on the last Saturday of every month at Oakland Public Works' Bulky Block Parties.

Safely Dispose of Hazardous Materials

Hazardous material such as fuel, paint, and medical sharps should be disposed for free at Alameda County's Household Hazardous Waste Facility at 2100 E. 7th Street in Oakland.

Be Careful With Private Haulers!

Too often, a "good deal" from a private hauler means that hauler is dumping your stuff onto a nearby Oakland street. Request a dump receipt from anyone hauling your stuff before you pay them. Use only permitted haulers to remove construction and demolition debris.

Report dumping to OAK311

Report dumping in your neighborhood to OAK311. City crews track where cleanup efforts are needed, and enforcement officers work to hold dumpers accountable.

Oakland's Adopt a Spot program supports groups and individuals in upkeep of neighborhood public spaces. Volunteers have adopted hundreds of sites around Oakland.
