BULKY JUNK DROP OFFS AND PICKUPS FOR ALL

At no additional cost with your trash service!

Oakland residents who live in apartments can now directly schedule a drop off and a curbside pickup appointment at no cost and without property manager approval.



DROP OFF

Schedule a one-time drop off of up to four cubic yards of bulky waste at the Davis Street Resource Recovery Complex in San Leandro.



CURBSIDE PICKUP

Directly schedule an appointment with WMAC to get rid of up to four cubic yards of waste, plus a limited number of large items.

Please expect curbside pickups at apartments to be scheduled the last week of each month. Some exceptions may occur. Appointments will not be available from Dec 27 - Jan 14 due to holiday tree pick ups.

Helpful Tools for Sorting Correctly

Oakland Recycles offers a convenient reusable tote bag to collect your recycling in your unit and transport to the building's recycle cart or bin.

Don't throw those food scraps away, use a kitchen pail to collect them and just empty into the compost cart or bin. Contact CWS or City of Oakland (see below) for hours and locations to pick up bags and pails.

Recycle Right!

All recycling should be empty, dry, and loose in the recycle cart/bin. Plastic bags and film are trash.



Place dry cell alkaline household batteries, bagged in a plastic bag, here.



Place extra cardboard (bundled) here.

Contact CWS for a free motor oil and filter recycle kit.

Place extra yard waste (bagged/bundled) here.



Tie branches up (< 4' long and 6" wide). Bag plant debris in large paper gardening bags or cardboard boxes. Plant debris in plastic bags will be charged as extra trash.

Never Pour Fats, Oil & Grease (FOG) Down the Drain!

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)
