Oakland Eviction Moratorium Phase-Out

The Eviction Moratorium ends on July 15, 2023. However, that does not mean that you will be evicted! There are several permanent tenant protections that will remain:

- If you were unable to pay your rent between March 9, 2020, and July 14, 2023, because of the Covid-19 pandemic, you can never be evicted over that unpaid rent.
 - You do still have to pay your rent starting on July 15, 2023 (August 1, 2023, for most tenants).
 - Your property owner can still take you to court over any unpaid rent accrued between March 9, 2020, and July 14, 2023.
- If you live in a rent-controlled dwelling unit, the property owner cannot raise your rent over the <u>annual allowable amount</u> until July 1, 2024. This means no banked or petition-based rent increases.
