

REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON MEASURE Z Notice of Issuance of Proposed Regulations Interpreting the **Oakland Hotel Minimum Wage and Working Conditions Law**

(Oakland Municipal Code Section 5.93 et seq.)

Pursuant to Measure Z, the Oakland Hotel Minimum Wage and Working Conditions Law (passed by voters in November of 2018), the City Administrator's Office (CAO) proposes to issue the attached interpretive regulations after considering all comments, objections, and recommendations regarding the proposed regulations.
