

Screening Panel Application 2020-21 Redistricting Commission

Overview

The Redistricting Commission Screening Panel is a three-member panel charged with reviewing applications for the City's independent Redistricting Commission and developing a qualified pool of 30 applicants that reflect the geographic, racial, ethnic and economic diversity of the City of Oakland.

The Screening Panel will review and deliberate all eligible applications in June/July 2020 and determine the qualified pool of 30 applicants by early-August 2020.

The Redistricting Commission is an independent body that will determine the district lines for Oakland City Council and Oakland Unified School District elections.

Screening Panel members cannot serve on the Redistricting Commission. For more information on the Screening Panel and redistricting process visit: www.oaklandca.gov/redistricting.

Complete and submit this application, along with a letter of interest and current resume. In your letter of interest, describe how you would prioritize the advancement of equitable outcomes for all people and communities in Oakland and prevent the root causes of disparate outcomes, as you review and screen the Redistricting Commission applications.

To serve on the Screening Panel you must meet the eligibility requirements AND be one of the following. Check the statement(s) that apply to you.

Eligibility Requirements
 Must be a resident of the City of Oakland for at least the three years preceding the date of this application.
 A student temporarily residing outside of the Oakland city limits may claim Oakland as their residence if they intend to return.
 Must not have a conflict of interest, as defined in the Political Reform Act of 1974, commencing at Section 81000 of the Government Code.
 Must not be a current paid employee of the City of Oakland, Oakland Unified School District or serve on a City of Oakland or Oakland Unified School District Board or Commission. Must not, within the five years immediately preceding the date of this application, be a paid employee of any redistricting contractor or consultant. Must not, including your spouse, parents, children, or registered domestic partner, within 10 years
immediately preceding the date of this application be: o Elected to, or a candidate for office for the City of Oakland or the Oakland School Board; or o An employee, or paid consultant or contractor to a campaign for local office; or o Registered or required to be registered as a local lobbyist; or
 A paid employee of, a consultant to, or under contract with any elected City of Oakland Official or Oakland Unified School Board Member; or A principal officer of an active campaign committee domiciled in Alameda County that has
 made an expenditure on local Oakland candidate elections. Must not have contributed 50% or more of the allowable amount to candidates for City of Oakland and Oakland Unified School District elective office in the election preceding the application date. In 2019, the 50% contribution amount that cannot be exceeded is \$400 for individuals.
Must not be registered to vote in a polling place located outside of Oakland city limits.
Disclaimer and Certification
In applying to serve on the Redistricting Commission Screening Panel, you certify that you:
 Are 18 years of age or older. Meet the eligibility requirements to serve on the Screening Panel. Will be subject to a background check if selected.
