- * UPGRADE RESTROOMS FOR ADA COMPLIANCE
- * EXPAND PASSIVE RECREATION AREAS (SUNBATHING, PICNICING)
- * PRESERVE EXISTING MATURE TREES
- * PROVIDE HANDICAP ACCESS TO MORE AREAS
- * PROVIDE SENSE OF ENTRY AND PLACE

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

GROUP PLANTINGS BY WATER REQUIREMENTS

PLANT LAWN ONLY WHERE "USEFUL", THAT IS, FOR

- SUNBATHING, PICNICING OR SPORTS PLANT LOW-WATER USAGE PLANTS IN OTHER AREAS
- * CONSIDER SPECIAL PLANTING
- AREAS FOR: NATIVE GARDEN
- * BIRD SANCTUARY
- * BUTTERFLY GARDEN
- * COMMUNITY GARDEN
- * ETHNIC / IMMIGRANT GARDEN (PLANTS FROM IMMIGRANTS' PRIOR COUNTRIES

IRRIGATION

- DESIGN IRRIGATION BY ZONES FOR EFFICIENT WATER USE
- * LIMIT WATER NEAR OAKS
 * SCHEDULE CONTROLLER FOR
- SEASONAL VARIATIONS

LIGHTING

- ADD (N) PATH LIGHTING
- * UPGRADE (E) LIGHT FIXTURES
- PAINT (E) LIGHT POLES
- * USE (N) ENERGY-EFFICIENT FIXTURES
- PREVENT LIGHT POLLUTION
- ONTO NEIGHBORING HOUSING AREAS
- COMPLY WITH CITY OF OAKLAND "DARK SKY" REGULATIONS
