The Oakland Department of Transportation (OakDOT) will be repaving Broadway between Embarcadero and 6th Street.

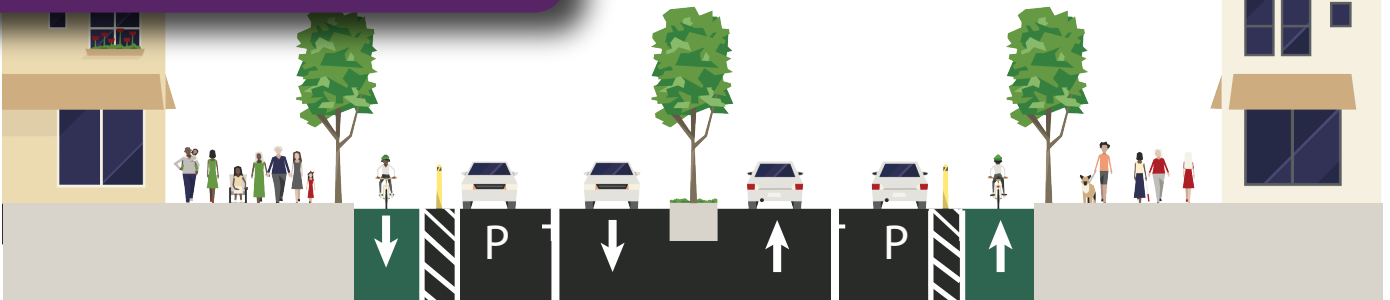
Current condition

Broadway is part of Oakland's High Injury Network, meaning it has a high rate of fatal or injury crashes. These are mostly due to speeding and poor pedestrian visibility.



Proposed improvement

A new stop sign at 2nd St, separated bikeways, and pedestrian safety zones will make it easier to cross the street. Pedestrian safety zones will also provide spaces for creative painting in the street.

The Oakland Department of Transportation (OakDOT) will be repaving Broadway between Embarcadero and 6th Street.

Safer Crosswalks

All crosswalks will be upgraded to "high visibility." Painted Pedestrian Safety Zones will narrow the street crossing and improve visibility.

Parking-protected bikeways

Separated bike lanes reduce conflict between bikes and cars.

New Stop Sign

An all-way stop will be added at Broadway & 2nd Street.
