City of Oakland Releases First Set of Documents in Officer-Involved Shooting of Joshua Pawlik

Oakland, CA – Pursuant to SB 1421, the City is releasing the first of many records related to the officer-involved shooting of Mr. Joshua Pawlik, which occurred on March 11, 2018.

The documents released today are posted [here](#) and include:

1. A report by the Oakland Police Department's Executive Force Review Board (EFRB) reviewing the officer-involved shooting which resulted in Mr. Pawlik's death;
2. OPD Chief Kirkpatrick's analysis of the incident to determine whether the shooting was in violation of law or policy and her administrative findings, including a frame-by-frame video analysis of the officer-involved shooting prepared by OPD's Internal Affairs Division, presented as an addendum to the EFRB Report; and
3. Federal Court-appointed Compliance Director Robert Warshaw's analysis of the incident and subsequent administrative findings, presented as an addendum to the EFRB report.

The Community Police Review Agency (CPRA) conducts an independent analysis of officer-involved shootings; their investigation into this shooting is currently underway and not yet concluded.

The City is releasing these records even though the investigation is ongoing and the administrative findings are not final, as required by [SB 1421](#).

The City will continue releasing records related to the report, investigation, and findings of this incident on a rolling basis as they are reviewed and redacted in accordance with the law.
